INTRODUCTION AND OBJECTIVES

This talk addresses the key aspects of building a robust IP portfolio, and also provides tips on building a good IP portfolio within the constraints of limited budget and resources.

The talk will be followed by a one-on-one mentoring IP clinic, where the speaker and her team will assess the IP assets of the company, and give an advice on the best IP strategy based on the current product development stage and product development plan.

Patent Strategy Score™ is a number between 0-10, a high Patent Strategy Score™ indicates a well thought of Patent Strategy and indicates the company has taken steps towards building a defensible and distinguishing Patent Portfolio and has minimized the risks.
