INTRODUCTION

Event will cover an overview of the various procedures and documents involved in the technology transfer process in academic and research institutions. The discussion will address, in a practical manner, the key issues in the process - from the initial IP due diligence stage, through how one decides on the particular route of IP commercialization, to aspects relating to the management of licensees post-execution of a licence agreement, and dealing with an institutions' spin-out companies. Separate session will cover talk on various patent infringement cases, factors for analyzing infringement, rulings/ decision of the court etc.

Event will also cover avenues available for technology commercialization. The focus will be on TREMAP, a government funding scheme open to individual innovators to commercialize their technology through licensing.
