Course focused on basic concepts of systematic innovation using a TRIZ-based approach. <b>Workshop on Patent drafting and procedures –</b> The workshop helps to understand patent prosecution, acquire skill for drafting patent specification and claims, understand and prepare documentation for patent prosecution, drafting of Technology transfer instruments, detailed information relating to Procedure, forms and fees in respect of Indian patent applications, to understand provisions relating to International applications under Indian patent Act. The workshop commenced on 17 <sup>th</sup> August 2010 and will end on 30 <sup>th</sup> September 2010. The workshop co-ordinator is Mr. A.D Kulkarni. There are a total of 11 participants for the course.
<b>Workshop on Patents for Researcher</b> - The workshop aims to provide researchers with insights and practical understanding of the global patent systems and how patent systems are being used by leading technology organizations to create value from laboratory science. The emphasis is on helping inventors be better informed and more effective. The workshop commenced on 13 <sup>th</sup> August 2010 and will end on 13 <sup>th</sup> November 2010. There are a total of 66 participants for the course.
<b>Intellectual Property Foundations</b> – This course covers basics concepts of Patents, Trademarks and Copyrights and its role in society and business. The course is a certificate course and commenced on 14 <sup>th</sup> August 2010 and will end in November 2010. The course director is Mr. Hasit Seth. There are a total of 11 participants for the course.
